AWARE LA

Alliance of White Anti-Racists Everywhere (AWARE) LA focuses on the following activities: Saturday Dialogue, White People 4 Black Lives, and Unmasking Whiteness. Saturday Dialogue is a gathering for white anti-racists who want to discuss issues of identity, community, privilege and racism in our lives with the intention to strengthen our practice as anti-racists in alliances, relationships, and interactions with people of color; White People 4 Black Lives is a white anti-racist collective and activist project of AWARE. Operates within a national network of white anti-racists- Showing Up for Racial Justice (SURJ). Work includes acting in solidarity with the Movement for Black Lives, Black Lives Matter LA, and other partners. Unmasking Whiteness is an intensive 4-day institute, which invites white people to deepen their self-awareness and build community with other white people taking up work for racial justice. The institute invites the exploration of subjects such as: white privilege, institutional racism, and development of an anti-racist practice and identity.
